#### General Meeting Information

The Palomar Orchid Society regularly meets the FIRST WEDNESDAY of every month 4:00-7:00PM, at the George and Patricia Gowland Meeting Room located in the Carlsbad <u>City Library</u> on Dove Lane, just off El Camino Real in southern Carlsbad. The address is 1775 Dove Lane, Carlsbad, CA 92011.

Traveling South on I-5, take the Poinsettia Ln. Traveling West on S-78, take the San Marcos exit and travel east to El Camino Real. Turn Blvd. exit and travel west, continuing on right on El Camino Real and turn right again Palomar Airport Rd.. Turn left on El Camino on Dove Lane.

If traveling North on I-5, take the La Costa Ave. exit and travel east to El Camino Real. Turn left on Dove Lane (first traffic light after Aviara Pkwy.)

Real and then turn right on Dove Lane.

The Dove library will be on your left and there is a large, well-lit parking lot. The Gowland Meeting Room is located on the right hand side of the main entrance.
