

#### **Orchid Culture - Repotting and Dividing Your Orchids**

Our first culture meeting of the year will review the basics of repotting and dividing orchids and feature demonstrations on repotting of easy to grow orchids in our climate. This is a very timely session as most orchids are beginning to put out new roots and pseudobulbs which is an ideal time to repot and divide your orchids. Two of our experienced growers, Alex Nadzan and Ed Danielewicz, will conduct the session. Alex Nadzan, POS President, will briefly review repotting basics including reasons and timing for repotting, then demonstrate how to repot and divide a few of his cattleya orchids.

Ed Danielewicz is a newer member of our society who has been growing orchids for many years (more detail on Ed's background below). Ed will repot and divide one of his oncidiums and a cymbidium. During the demonstration, both speakers will address any repotting questions you may have so bring them to the meeting.



Ed Danielewicz has been a member of the San Diego Orchid Society since the early 1980's and has been growing orchids outside in Carlsbad for over 40 years. He has a PhD in Electrical Engineering from the University of Illinois in Champaign Urbana, Illinois. Ed retired from his career as a laser physicist in 2015 but has been a consultant on deep ultraviolet lasers (DUV) and optics in his own company since then. For the past 25 years he has been involved with developing the DUV lasers used for manufacturing computer chips in the semiconductor industry.

Ed's interest in orchids was stimulated by John Walters of Rex Foster Orchids who sold him his first orchid and stimulated him with his infectious enthusiasm. In addition to orchids, Ed grows bromeliads, heliconia, palms, cycads, euphorbias, cacti, ginger and many other plants in his garden in La Costa. He joined the Palomar Orchid Society only recently after meeting Alex Nadzan, a fellow U.of I. graduate, at the World of Orchids Show at the

San Diego Botanic Garden.

#### President's Message

March 2025

Hello to all POS members and Friends,

Well, we finally got some much needed rain in mid-February but we are still well below our normal rainfall for southern California. Hopefully, there will be more showers toward the end of February and early March. We are beginning to see signs of activity in blooming of Aussie dendrobiums and cymbidiums along with winter/early spring blooming cattleyas. Now is the time to prepare for the upcoming spring growing season by stocking up on materials such as bark, pots, and fertilizers but make sure you also have a supply of appropriate pesticides and fungicides as well.

March also brings one of the biggest orchid shows to our area, the Santa Barbara International Orchid Show running from March 7th to 9th. If you haven't attended this show, it is well worth the trip. In addition to the show having a number of excellent orchid vendors (see ad pg. 6), several of the Santa Barbara area nurseries will be open including Cal Orchid and the Santa Barbara Orchid Estate just to name two.

In line with the beginning of the growing season, our March meeting will feature a culture session devoted to repotting and dividing your orchids. Two of our experienced growers, Alex Nadzan and Ed Danielewicz, will review the basics of when to repot and divide your orchids and repot some cattleyas, oncidiums, and cymbidiums. Last month Fred Clarke gave an excellent talk on 'Cycnoches, Mormodes and Catasetums – Recent Trends' He discussed in detail on how to grow these very interesting orchids and highlighted several of the wonderful species and hybrids of these fascinating, deciduous orchids that he has produced. Fred is always a very entertaining and informative speaker and an expert on this class of orchids. We are very lucky to have him as a life member and very generous supporter of our society.

SDCOS will be hosting their Spring Orchids in the Park Show in Balboa Park over Easter Weekend on April 18-20 so please plan to attend and support our sister society and our local vendors that will be selling orchids and orchid supplies at the show. There will be no society displays due to limited space but we encourage our members to enter their individual plants to display for ribbon judging or AOS judging, if they so desire. Please refer to the <u>SDCOS</u> website for information on the show and the submission of plants for display. In addition to the commercial vendor sales, several society members will be selling their own plants at the show as well as the orchid conservation group.

Please plan to renew your POS Membership early or join if you have not already done so. These fees are minimal but are important and help cover the speaker fees, opportunity tables, meeting room costs and other operating expenses. Mail renewals to POS, P.O. Please refer to the <u>POS</u> or <u>AOS</u> websites for orchid culture tips for this time of the year. It is also important to plan and purchase your supplies before repotting, fertilizing, etc. When repotting be sure to have on hand a variety of pot sizes, because you can't always predict if you will be dividing or upsizing the plant. Also have available various sizes of orchid bark including small, medium and large. There are a number of sources of supplies, whether a local store or on-line retailer such as Amazon.com. Alex will be providing an updated handout on Orchid Repotting Basics at the March meeting and it also will be available for downloading from our website that lists on-line and local sources of orchid supplies under the pulldown for Meetings and <u>Speaker Handouts</u>. As always, we hope our members and friends remain healthy, upbeat and optimistic about the future. Alex is available to listen to your suggestions, questions, and concerns.
